NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island Open Meetings Act, R.I.G.L. 42-46-6 (b), the public is hereby notified that the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will hold an open meeting on **Wednesday, December 20, 2017 @ 10 A.M.** in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island for the purpose of discussing, deliberating and/or voting on the following dockets. Because this is not a hearing, the PUC will not be accepting oral public comments.

Docket No. 4611 – Kent County Water Authority (KCWA) - Review and deliberation on KCWA's October 27, 2017 Step Increase Rate Filing and responsive memorandum submitted by the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division). KCWA seeks to increase its rates to collect additional revenues of \$1,057,660 or 4.73 percent effective January 1, 2018.

Docket No. 4762 – Pascoag Utility District – Review and deliberation on Pascoag Utility's Annual Reconciliation Filing of the Standard Offer Service Rate, Transmission Charge and Transition Charge submitted on November 7, 2017. Pascoag Utility seeks to implement these rate changes effective January 1, 2018. This docket is on the agenda in the event there is not a bench decision at the December 19, 2017 hearing.

Docket No. 4761 – Pascoag Utility District – Review and deliberation on Pascoag Utility's proposed 2018 Demand Side Management (DSM) Filing, budget and associated DSM charge. The filing was submitted on November 2, 2017. This docket is on the agenda in the event there is not a bench decision at the December 19, 2017 hearing.

Docket No. 4738 – Pascoag Utility District – Review and deliberation on Pascoag Utility's September 20, 2017 tariff advice to introduce a Municipal Low Capacity Factor and responsive memorandum submitted in response thereto by the Division.

Docket No. 4743 – Tesla, Inc. and Sunrun, Inc. (Petitioners) – This docket relates to the Petitioners Petition for Declaratory Judgment or an Advisory Ruling on R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.4, the Net Metering Act. The PUC will review and deliberate on Tesla Inc.'s November 30, 2017 Motion to Reopen and responsive pleadings submitted thereto. Comments were submitted by Sunrun, Inc., The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid and Northeast Clean Energy Council.

Docket No. 4604 – RI Office of Energy Resources (OER) - Review and deliberation on OER's November 16, 2017 budgetary request of Sixty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$68,000.00) to perform the ceiling price study for the 2019 Renewable Energy Growth program year.

Docket No. 4290 – RI Dept. of Human Service (DHS) – Review and deliberation on the DHS' November 2, 2017 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Enhancement Plan Rates for 2018 for gas and electric customers and responsive pleading

submitted thereto by the Division. DHS requests that the LIHEAP Enhancement Charge remain at eighty-one cents per month for each customer for the calendar year 2018.

Docket No. 4775 – The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid – Review and deliberation on National Grid’s November 15, 2017 proposed Long-Term Contracting for Renewable Energy Recovery Factor (LTC Recovery Factor) of \$0.00622 per kWh, effective for the period January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018. The Division submitted Memorandums on the Company’s filing.

Docket No. 4755 - National Grid – Review and deliberation on a Settlement Agreement executed between The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid, the Division, the Office of Energy Resources, the Energy Efficiency and Resources Management Council, Acadia Center and People’s Power & Light. The Settlement Agreement requests for approval of National Grid’s 2018 Energy Efficiency Program Plan (EEPP), budget and associated Energy Efficiency Charge.

Docket No. 4756 – National Grid – Review and deliberation on the System Reliability Procurement (SRP) Report, an agreement between The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid, the Division, the Office of Energy Resources, the Energy Efficiency and Resources Management Council, Acadia Center and People’s Power & Light. In the Report, the parties seek of approval of National Grid’s proposed budget to fund the purchase of non-wires alternative resources projects.
