DESCRIPTION

Come join us for a tour of the South Street Landing Building located in the heart of Providence's new Knowledge District. The redevelopment of the existing South Street Power Station building is now a 265,000sf mixed-use facility, providing program space for Rhode Island College, the University of Rhode Island, and Brown University. The building houses a collaborative 130,000sf Nursing Education Center (NEC) shared by both Rhode Island College and the University of Rhode Island, as well as 135,000sf of space for Brown University administrative offices. The multi-tenant project structure defined requirements for the pursuit of separate LEED v3 certifications: for the overall core and shell project and for the NEC tenant improvement project. The project is projecting an energy savings of 17.8% over the minimum energy code. The tour will focus on energy efficient measures incorporated into the building design to help achieve this energy use savings.

Prior to the building tour there will be a Rhode Island Commercial Energy Code compliance training and refreshments. This training will demonstrate how this project is in compliance with the current energy code.
