To do so, the Council may vote to enter an Executive Session (also referred to as a closed meeting) pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-4(a). The business to be discussed and the statutory purpose of entering into an Executive Session, is R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-5(a)(7): "A matter related to the question of the investment of public funds where the premature disclosure would adversely affect the public interest."

b) Council Discussion & Vote on Legal Service Proposal Selection and 2020 Legal Services Budget Increase (5 min, 5:10 – 5:15pm)

The Council's Review Committee will provide a recommendation to the full Council on the selection of legal services. The Council will discuss the recommendation and the proposals, and will vote on selection.

To do so, the Council may vote to enter an Executive Session (also referred to as a closed meeting) pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-4(a). The business to be discussed and the statutory purpose of entering into an Executive Session, is R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-5(a)(7): "A matter related to the question of the investment of public funds where the premature disclosure would adversely affect the public interest."

The Council will also review and discuss a recommended legal services budget increase for 2020. The Council will vote on approval of this recommendation.

c) Council Review, Discussion & Vote of 2021 Planning Timeline & Meeting Material Submission Process (15 min, 5:15 – 5:30pm)

The Council's Consultant Team will present a proposed planning timeline for 2021. The Council will discuss and provide feedback.
