Notification to Division of PUC for spending in excess of 110% of portfolio

Gas EnergyWise may trigger spending in excess of 110% of portfolio

Explain overspend to PUC in Year End Report

EnergyWise will continue to serve customers with the understanding that due to strong demand, lead times can be longer

EnergyWise Spending and Savings

Robust pipeline from three months of program shutdown (2020) produced customer backlog

Strong contractor workforce from re-engagement efforts in 2020


Strong customer interest in home improvements
