Annual Report Requirements

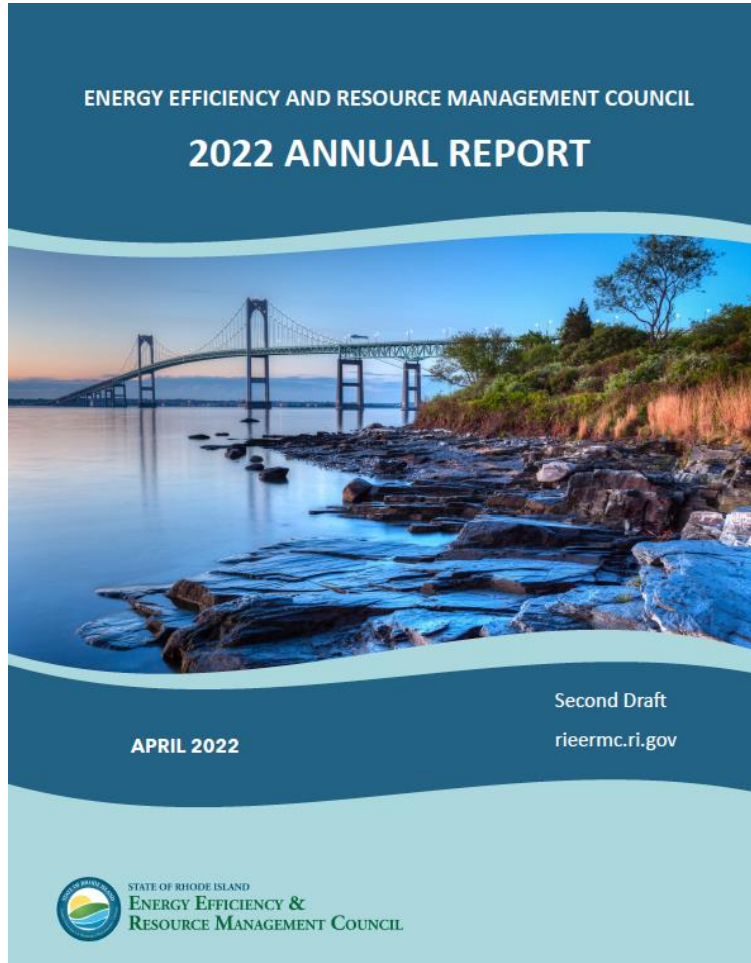
The Powers and Duties section of the EERMC's enabling legislation requires the Council to:

“Submit to the joint committee on energy an annual report on/or before April 15 of each year, commencing in 2008, regarding

- The activities of the council,*
- Its assessment of energy issues,*
- The status of system reliability, energy efficiency and conservation procurement, and*
- Recommendations regarding any improvements which might be necessary or desirable”*

Annual Report Third Draft

- Includes 2021 Final Year-End Results from the Company
- Council Purpose
 - Added language about protecting the SBC
- New Section – Context Informing Policy Recommendations and EE Priorities
 - Sale of the Utility
 - First ever contested EE Plan
 - Intersection of EE and Climate Change impacts
- Policy Recommendations
 - Updated language in item 4 to emphasize the need to embed equity in EE programs
- EERMC Priorities for the 2023 EE Plan
 - Added a sixth priority on climate mandates
- Council Public Education Efforts
 - Additional language to emphasize Council’s commitment to equity inclusion in EERMC priorities and policy recommendations



EERMC Annual Report: Timeline

- March 17 – Council Meeting: Present first draft
- April 1 – Initial feedback due from Council members, etc.
- *April 15 – Official due date*
- April 27 – Council Meeting: Present second draft, possible vote
- May 12 – Post updated draft
- June 1– Final numbers received from the Company
- June 16– Council Meeting: Present final report and vote
