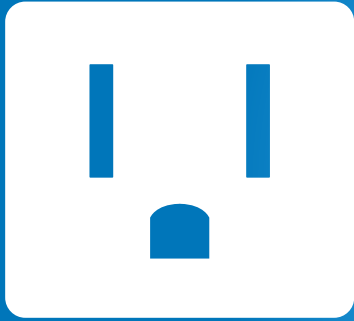


Why does my utility...

efficiency



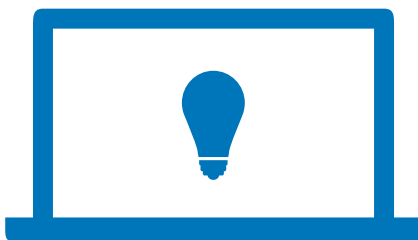
Rhode Island law **requires** the utility to invest in energy efficiency if it's cheaper than purchasing more power.



Using less energy reduces costs to maintain the grid. If we all use less, then we lower energy bills for **everyone**.



Your utility's profits are determined by the cost to maintain the energy grid, **NOT** by how much electricity it sells.
