2025 LEAD Session Possible Topics



Public Utilities Commission (PUC) Discussion – Continued conversation on energy efficiency in RI with PUC staff following February Council meeting.

ACEEE State Scorecard – Explanation of RI's ranking drop and discussion of opportunities to strengthen EE programs and policies in RI.

Least Cost Procurement (LCP) Standards — Continued discussion of possible updates to LCP Standards, including annual and three-year efficiency planning cycles.

State Climate Efforts – Update on EC4 Climate Action Strategy and opportunity to discuss EEC's role in statewide climate efforts.

EEC Education Efforts – Open brainstorm on possible directions for future education work, informed by lessons learned from public awareness campaign.

Market Potential Study (MPS) Alternatives – Picking up on idea proposed at Fall 2024 LEAD Session to explore alternatives to traditional MPS for updating data that will inform upcoming target setting.

Discussion with Contractor – Invite non-company affiliated vendor to share on-the-ground perspective of current workforce landscape, challenges and opportunities in customer engagement, and delivering energy efficiency services in the field.
